

HAWLEY TOWNSHIP DUST CONTROL POLICY

Hawley Township in order to improved public safety, help maintain road stability, and improve road drivability, here by establishes the following Dust Control Policy;

Residential;

1. The township will cost share dust control application costs at a rate to be set By the town board by 1 March of each year. Reimbursement cost can be up to but not exceed 50% of costs. Town residents will be notified by the township by 1 April of that year's reimbursement rate.
2. Cost Share is available to all township residents who reside on a township maintained road. Residents who reside on state or county maintained road are not eligible.
3. Residents are responsible to order, mark, and pay in full the invoice for dust control for the year. For reimbursement from the township the resident must submit a copy of the original invoice and proof of payment to the township by 1 August of the year of application.
4. The Township has no responsibility for ordering, marking, application, or invoicing of any dust control

COMMERICAL;

1. The township will cost share dust control application costs at a rate to be set by the town board by 1 March of each year. Reimbursement cost can be up to but not exceed 50% of costs. Town residents will be notified by the township by 1 April of that year's reimbursement rate.
2. Cost share is available to all businesses who reside on a township maintained road. Business located on state and county maintained roads are not eligible.
3. Businesses are responsible to order, mark, and pay in full the invoice for the dust control. For reimbursement form the township the business must

submit a copy of the original invoice and proof of payment to the Township by 1 August of year of application.

4. The Township has no responsibility for ordering, marking, application, or invoicing of any dust control.
